

Galvin's Park Rules

Existing Rules:

1. No person, except those camping in designated areas, shall enter or remain within any park between the hours of 10PM and 6AM.
2. No person shall camp in any portion of a park except in portions prescribed or designated by the Council, and the City may refuse camping privileges or rescind any and call camping privileges for cause.
3. Permitted uses of the upper level of Galvin Park include camping, recreation, and picnic activities. Permitted uses of the lower level of the Galvin Park area include recreational activities.
4. When registering guest must provide all information requested on registration envelope and deposit envelop, with registration fee, in the onsite registration and deposit box.
5. All camping vehicles and camping equipment must be of a nature that it does not pose a danger or nuisance to other campers or the property. Two vehicles are allowed per paid site. A vehicle pulling a camper would constitute one vehicle. A motor home pulling a car would constitute two vehicles.
6. Registrants and their guests are responsible for damages to the park and/its facilities.
7. No Keg Beer or glass bottles allowed within Galvin Park
8. All fires and cooking equipment must be attended at all times and adequate fire precautions taken. No other fires are permitted. All oil cookers must be used in fire rings. Fire rings may not be moved by campers.
9. Loud music or other activity constituting a nuisance is prohibited. Quiet time is 10:30PM and all visitors must leave the park.
10. All violators of this section will be subject to citation and/or told to leave by the Sheffield City Police or other law enforcement officers. First violations of this section will result in a \$100 find per offense. Second violations will result in a \$250 fine per offense. Third & subsequent citations shall result in a \$500 find per offense.
