

RESOLUTION NO. 15-23

**A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD
DELINQUENT WATER & SEWER BILLS**

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Sheffield, Iowa:

That the following guidelines regarding DELINQUENT WATER & SEWER BILLS for the City OF Sheffield will go into effect on April 1st, 2015.

- The City Clerk will issue water to be shut off on the 25th day (of the month) of the second bill cycle of a delinquent water bill.
- The City Clerk will make account holder aware of the delinquent account via mailing prior to shut off and detailing options to avoid shut off (according to Ordinance 92.04)
- In accordance with Ordinance Number 92.04 and this policy, one 48 hour notice will be posted on the dwelling of the past due account explaining the reason for shut off.
- After receiving the 48 hour notice, the account must be paid in full to avoid shut off.
- In accordance with Ordinance Number 92.04, the account holder may request a public hearing in regards to their utility account.
- If water is turned off, there will be a \$75 reactivation fee added to the account balance.
- The City Council has the right to postpone water being shut off in order to avoid jeopardizing the City infrastructure.


