

The Sheffield City Council Special Session was called to order at Sheffield City Hall by Mayor Brad Mulford, at 6:00PM on Thursday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Council Members in attendance were Becky Moellers, Julia Showalter, James Robbins, Ryan Kruger, and Sherri McGuire. Also, in attendance was; Pat Nuehring, Public Works Director; Eric Meyer, Public Works Assistant, Bonnie Theis, Library Board President, Dan Fields, Fire Department Chief and Dave Schoning, Franklin County Rural Fire.

Mayor Mulford led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moellers made a motion approve the agenda. Kruger seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

#### **New Business**

- The Council discussed adding in a early bird family pool pass, decreasing the cost of the safety home nightly charge, increasing the after-hours burial cost, increasing the cost of a new/additional water meter, and increasing the water/sewer service fee for every 1000 gallon after the first 2000 gallons. Moellers motioned to the new fee schedule. Robbins seconded it; it was approved.
- Robbins motioned to approve the Resolution approving the Mayor to sign the Toyne purchase agreement. Kruger seconded it and roll call was as follows, Ayes: Moellers, Showalter, Robbins, Kruger, McGuire. Mayor Mulford declared the resolution approved, adopted and numbered 24-22.
- Moellers motioned to approve the purchase of a new Public Works pickup, from Pritchard's (\$46,448.35), with tommy gate, from Stellar (\$4909.00). Kruger seconded it; it was approved.
- Moellers motioned to approve the Resolution approving the Mayor to sign Pritchard's purchase agreement. Kruger seconded it and roll call was as follows, Ayes: Moellers, Showalter, Robbins, Kruger, McGuire. Mayor Mulford declared the resolution approved, adopted and numbered 24-23.
- Moellers motioned to approve the Resolution approving the City Clerk to move ARPA funds for a donation to the Sheffield Lions for the new digital sign. Robbins seconded it and roll call was as follows, Ayes: Moellers, Showalter, Robbins, Kruger, McGuire. Mayor Mulford declared the resolution approved, adopted and numbered 24-24.
- There was discussion on the updated budget from Monday, 1/15/24, night's department requests. There was a discussion on the Fire Department increase in wages to cover the required training hours. Councilman Moellers asked Chief Fields to inform the fireman that they will get the required 24 hours paid and above that wouldn't be paid. Chief Fields said he would get that in the bylaws. PW Director asked for \$2000 be added into the sewer budget to maintain the trees on 1<sup>st</sup> street again this FY25.

Kruger motioned to adjourn the meeting. Showalter seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Adjournment at 6:30PM.
